
## INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLING "E" FOG LIGHT BRACKETS ON 1941 STUDEBAKER COMMANDER & PRESIDENT.



- l. Figures 1 & 2 show front and side elevations, respectively, of installation without bumperette. Figure 3 shows side elevation with bumperette as extra equipment.
- 2. Remove inside bolt toward center of car that holds upper bumper in place. (Fig. 1)
- 3. Place road lamp bracket inside of upper bumper with tapped hole over and in line with 3/8" hole. (Fig. 2)
  - 4. Replace 3/8" bolt  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " long by screwing into tapped hole in bracket.
- 5. Where pair of lamps is being installed, perform same operation on other side of bumper.
- 6. If bumperette, as extra equipment, is installed, follow same instructions but use 3/8" bolt 7/8" long, and 3/8" bushing provided, in place of 3/8" bolt  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " long, as in Figure 3.
- 7. Complete wiring and setting of lamps in accordance with instructions in enclosed sheet.
