
INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLING "G" FOG LIGHT BRACKETS ON 1942 NASH STANDARD MODELS



- 1. Spot line on apron (Fig. 2) four inches (4") from bumper guard center line as indicated in Figure 1.
- 2. At center of this line, where it crosses raised head of apron, spot and drill ½" hole. (See Figure 2).
- 3. Place part 4002-S1 on top of apron; Part 4002-P, Part 4002-S2 beneath apron. Place lock washer over bolt and push it through this bracket assembly. Then place the lamp over the bracket and screw the bolt into lamp shell bracket.
- 4. Remove nuts from bolts A (Figs. 1 and 2) and B (Fig. 2). Place brace (Nash Part 3119219) over bolts and replace the nuts, drawing up tightly. (See Figure 2).
- 5. Complete wiring installation and focusing of lamps in accordance with separate instruction sheet enclosed in lamp carton.
